- f) Notwithstanding the provisions of Republic Act No. 6758 and Compensation Circular No. 10, Series of 1989 issued by the Department of Budget and Management, the board shall have the authority to provide for the organizational structure and staffing pattern of SB Corporation and to extend to the employees and personnel thereof salaries, allowances and fringe benefits similar to those extended to and currently enjoyed by the employees and personnel of other government financial institutions.

Section VII Disclosure and Transparency

1. Financial Reporting

Item 67. SB Corporation shall prepare the consolidated financial statements and the condensed set of financial statements contained in the half-yearly financial report in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), as adopted by the Philippines. Annual financial reports shall be published at the latest four months after the end of the reporting period, half-yearly financial rep[orts at the latest two months after the end of the reporting period, and shall be publicly available for at least five years.

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The approval by the Board of the release of the annual FS (prior to its submission to COA) is already being observed. The inclusion of the statement by the Board confirming the truth and fairness of the financial statements is being required by GCG MC No. 2012-07.
