SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NOTICE TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS ADDENDUM NO. 7

Series of 2022 UPGRADING OF FIREWALL APPLIANCES

A special BAC meeting has been held last 27 September 2022 to clarify some items raised by prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on September 23, 2022. BAC resolution includes the following:

1. Lead Time (delivery period)

The delivery period shall be ninety (90) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed. This supersedes the information given in the Bidding Document under Section I and Section III.

4. NFCC Computation

NFCC = [(Current assets minus current liabilities) (K)] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under ongoing contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract to be bid.

Where: K = 10 for a contract duration of one year or less, 15 for a contract duration of more than one year up to two years, and 20 for a contract duration of more than two years.
